

Literacy

In Literacy We will continue to develop phonics knowledge as we embed Phase 3/4 Little Wandle letters, sounds and tricky words. We will enhance our passion for reading through our class topic and continue reading and sharing books with you at home. The children will continue to develop skills in sentence structuring which include using finger spaces, capital letters and full stops, whilst focusing on speaking and listening skills. The children will be supported to build and write sentences independently. Children will participate in drawing club to develop the love of reading, learning new vocabulary and creating their own stories.

PSED

Personal, Social and Emotional Development will focus on skills in social boundaries, developing knowledge of right and wrong and exploring transitions in school. We will encourage the children to face the challenges of play, friendships and focused work independently showing a developing sense of self confidence and care and concern for each other.

Understand the World

Children will explore the learning environment each week where they will be encouraged to take part in learning through play, developing on their own interests, knowledge and experiences. Children will explore various weekly focused activities based on the topic 'Fairy Tales' in which we will develop knowledge on fictional verse's factual, explore real life objects used in stories, places around the world, and what truly makes a fairy tale magical.

Math. In Maths the children will continue to develop counting and subitising skills and number recognition through daily focused math sessions using mastering numbers programme. The children will explore numbers and numerical patterns with numbers to 10 and beyond. The child will also develop knowledge of spatial Reasoning using shapes and patterns through focused play and exploration.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will be given the opportunity to get creative using various art materials, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. The children will develop knowledge and skills on the safe use of materials, tools and techniques whilst creating their masterpieces focused on topic work and celebrations.

RE

The children will be exploring and embedding their knowledge of God, who is God? How can he help us? Why do Christians worship God?

Communication and Language

Children will continue to develop communication and language skills through focused activities and free play. A focus will be placed on the learning of new vocabulary and the children having a voice as they are encouraged to participate in all activities and discussions.

Physical Development

Children will continue to develop fine and gross motor skills through focused PE sessions (managed by trained PE instructors) as well as weekly balance bike sessions, and through the use of manipulatives within the classroom environment, aiming to give the children the skills required to effectively control their body movements in order to develop tricky skills e.g. pencil control.
